WHAT WE WON'T PRINT

We will only accept ORIGINAL work from the author. If the work is NOT YOUR OWN, please do not send it. By submitting any article for consideration, you warrant that you are the lawful author of the material and indemnify *Metier Media Pty Ltd* from any action brought under copyright law with respect to the material.

Material that promotes hatred or discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation, race, gender, age, religion, class, physical or mental ability will not be considered.

Blatantly promotional submissions with the sole intent of 'plugging' any commercial service or product will not be published as editorial content. If you wish to promote your business, workshop or product to *Spellcraft* readers, please consider our advertising options.

Book and product reviews are conducted in-house and rarely commissioned. If in doubt, contact us.

General submissions

Yes, we can accept handwritten articles if you do not have access to a computer. Please ensure that your article is printed clearly and neatly – so we can read it!

Photographs and artwork are also welcome, but please do not send originals as we cannot guarantee safe return.

COPYRIGHT

The Spirit Guide reserves first worldwide publishing rights to your article, should it be accepted, with the right to archive the material indefinitely. Articles are accepted on the understanding that you will not publish the same piece elsewhere, including online, without written permission of *The Spirit Guide*, for a period of six months from the end of the shelf-life of the issue in which it appears. After this period has elapsed, full rights return to you, with the proviso that the attribution: "This article first appeared in *The Spirit Guide to Spellcraft*, (issue date)" is included as a footnote to subsequent publications of the work, including online. You agree to notify us if the article appears elsewhere, including online.

Previously published material will be considered only if clearly not subject to copyright restrictions. Please tell us if your article has already been sent to another publisher or is pending approval elsewhere.

PAYMENT

The Spirit Guide to Spellcraft does not currently pay for reader contributions. Authors receive two copies of the issue in which their article appears, and a complimentary link on the *Spellcraft* website for the life of that edition.

We do not offer display advertising as payment for articles published, so please don't ask. Similarly, whilst advertising clients are very welcome to submit articles for consideration, purchase of advertising space does not guarantee your article will be published.



BEFORE YOU SEND IT

1. If you do not wish the article to be published under your real name remember to clearly state the ALIAS you wish to use.
2. If you would like us to include images or a photograph of yourself, please provide them with your submission. Be mindful to provide captions with every picture and the photographer's/artist's name.
3. Feel welcome to include a brief one-paragraph biography with your submission.
4. Ensure that you provide your name, address, a contact phone number and an email address where possible.
5. Submissions may be edited for punctuation, grammar, coherency and potential legal problems. Contributions may also be cut to "fit." To avoid any major changes or cutting of your work please attend to the following before sending in your work:
 - ⇒ Take a moment to proofread and check the spelling. (Australian Spelling)
 - ⇒ Your article should be between 500 and no more than 1200 words.
 - ⇒ If you really can not keep your piece to less than 1200 words then you may wish to send us a SAMPLE article so as our editorial team can assess the content and your writing style.
6. Be succinct.
7. Don't waffle.
8. Keep it simple.
9. Use informal, conversational, down-to-earth language.
10. Highlight keywords.
11. Check your facts! (Especially names, addresses and phone numbers)
12. Keep it clean.
13. Opinions expressed in *Spellcraft* are those of the individual authors or interview subjects, not necessarily those of the publisher.
14. The publisher does not accept any responsibility for material sent which may be lost or stolen and cannot cover freight, postage or handling of material sent.
